1994 SCREAMING EAGLE CABERNET SAUVIGNON (1.5L)

Get your claws on this, and it'll turn your beak red! You've heard the name **Screaming Eagle**, and you also know that catching a rare glimpse of the national bird is easier than seizing a **bottle of this elusive wine**.


Here's what Mr. Parker has to say about this majestic bird at the top o' the food chain...

"The 1994 Cabernet Sauvignon is performing even better this year than it was last. The opaque purple-colored 1994's forward, gorgeously-scented nose offers up a smorgasbord of black fruits, along with a subtle dosage of toasty oak and minerals. Full-bodied, with a seamless, lush texture, this is a profoundly generous wine with everything going for it. The finish lasts for 35 seconds. What makes Screaming Eagle such an extraordinary wine is its remarkably sweet, lavishly rich, opulently-textured, super-extracted black currant and black cherry fruitiness. Moreover, they are admirably pure, layered, velvety, and accessible. As delicious as these wines are young, they should age for 20 or more years, because of their extraordinary equilibrium. (RP) ."
